A Home Restored ... to be a Haven for Restorative Care

We made a big move to a new location for our HEART Home (HEART = Healing and Restoration Therapy). This will allow us to help more girls find healing and restorative care as well as giving us easier access to myriad services and activities that are both fun and beneficial. Yay!



What a journey it has been. After months of looking for an ideal location, finding it and then more months to restore it to a place of beauty, this has been an invaluable lesson while preparing for the work before us – providing restorative care to girls who have been abused.

Looking at the house from the outside, one can't tell all that's broken on the inside. The process of renovation involved fixing things that were in plain sight and then discovering damage that was not visible (e.g. blocked pipes, termite destruction, missing cables) – similar to the process of helping someone heal from trauma.



As we continue setting things up, we are so grateful for friends who have been coming alongside us on this journey both with time and resources – a landscaping crew sent to work on our compound, tons of books donated for a library, a gift to set up our counseling room, a bountiful stock of food items, clothes, stationery.
