


Thanking God for the most amazing hosts, new monthly partners, generous gifts in cash and kind which included undergarments and lovely backpacks for the girls.

It takes about \$100 a month to provide 1 girl with safe shelter, education, counseling and play. In order to better provide for our girls, we have merged our Club 120 Initiative and the sponsorship part of our 29:11 Scholarship Program into The GOOD Project (GOOD = Girls Out Of Danger).

When 10 people commit to give \$10 a month (about 33cents/sh a day – some change for GOOD), 1 girl is supported. We invite you to join us in supporting many more girls.


We are so grateful for our GOOD Heroes in Kenya and around the world who have taken up different numbers of \$10 spots – like 1, 5, 10, 20 spots – whatever is comfortable. Each **\$10 spot** goes a long way in making the difference from a life of exploitation to a life with a bright soaring future.

Each \$10 spot taken has the Hero's initials written in it. Our goal is to have all 200 spots taken by September 1st so that **20 girls** are supported each month. How many spots can you take up and be **a child's GOOD Hero** today?
